SOCKS protocol support settings

The SOCKS username and password are acquired in the following way. First, if the application has registered a `java.net.Authenticator` default instance, then this will be queried with the protocol set to the string "SOCKS5", and the prompt set to the string "SOCKS authentication". If the authenticator does not return a username/password or if no authenticator is registered then the system checks for the user preferences `java.net.socks.username` and `java.net.socks.password`. If these preferences do not exist, then the system property "user.name" is checked for a username. In this case, no password is supplied.

The previous information is taken from the Java Documentation and is copyrighted by Sun Microsystems.

I think I got this correct. Please see command line option `-sph` above for example use of username and password. Let me know if this works.
